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Discover the treasures of Beaune and its region, mixing great wines, gastronomy and heritage.



Suggestions for places to visit, for you to arrange according to your choice and site availability:

Guided tour of the Hôtel-Dieu (allow 1 hr 30)

Founded in 1443 by Nicolas Rolin, Chancellor to Philippe le Bon, a jewel of flamboyant Gothic architecture with its polychrome roofs and polyptych of the Last Judgement. This medieval hospital has many other treasures besides...



Tour of Beaune on the 'Visiotrain' (allow 1 hr)

For 45 minutes, take the slow train and listen to a guided tour describing the old city, major monuments, vineyards ... Sets off from the Rue de l'Hôtel-Dieu, opposite the museum.



Tour of the Moutarderie Fallot (mustard factory: allow 1 hr 30 - 2 hr, depending on your chosen tour)

The Fallot factory, the last independent, traditional Burgundy family mustard-maker, invites you to discover this legendary condiment that's famous around the world and yet so little is known about it...

Two tours are on offer: "Discovery" and "Strong Sensations". In both cases, from discovery to tasting, it's a chance to immerse yourself in the world of mustard you can't afford to miss!



Tour of Maison Veuve Ambal (allow 2 hr)

Experience for yourself the creation of a crémant de Bourgogne! A guide reveals the secrets of how the process works here. Learning all about its fermentation vats, its ageing cellars, workshops, robots and automated processes that support the traditional methods is fascinating. Projections on giant screens accompany you on your journey to the heart of the business. End your visit with a personalised tasting with commentary of three crémants de Bourgogne in the friendly atmosphere of the Veuve Ambal shop.



<u>Tasting tour of the Patriarche cellars</u> (allow 1 hr 30)

Located in the old Convent of the Visitation, the Patriarch Cellars are the largest in Burgundy and home to several million bottles. Step inside, wander through the maze of tunnels and discover the most prestigious appellations in Burgundy ... A magical, intense, timeless place apart which sums up the marriage of wine and culture.



Tasting tour of the Bouchard Aîné & Fils cellars (allow 1 hr 30)

Guided and personalised tour of the wine cellars. Discover the "Tour of the 5 senses": educational and entertaining, it lets you better describe and appreciate wine. Tasting with commentary at the end of the tour.
